Historic preservation and creative reuse and conversion of a 10,500 SF Presbyterian church built in 1893, into what was originally envisioned as a design coop and later became professional condominium offices and shops. Improvements included restructuring the building, providing handicap access, renovating the electrical, mechanical, plumbing, fire safety and energy systems to comply with current code requirements and refinishing the interiors in a contemporary style sympathetic to the building's original character. Designed, developed, and constructed by Ted Lehn, the Island Design Center is a familiar landmark in Friday Harbor and one of its best historic restorations.
